## MUSIC FOR KIDS AGE 2-3

Playtime is important for your child's development. Children learn through play by experimenting, practicing, and creating. Research shows music is a wonderful way to play that strengthens the bond between you and your child while also encouraging your child's developmental growth.

#### During these months, children are learning to:

- Speak in short sentences
- Enjoy observing and imitating others
- Understand instructions, but may refuse to do them
- Dance and hop on one foot

#### Music activities to encourage MOVEMENT:

- Play Where is Thumbkin & Itsy Bitsy Spider with your child.
- Have your child create their own hand movements for *Wheels on the Bus* and incorporate them into the song.
- Create a marching band and play instruments while marching around the room.
- Play "follow the leader" and have your child follow you around the room marching, jumping, walking fast and slow, etc. Have your child lead by creating their own movements. Play recorded music while moving.
- Sing *Head and Shoulders* and have your child follow along by doing the actions.
- Play a musical game of fast and slow. Sing a song you know and change the speed of the song each time through.

#### Music activities to encourage LANGUAGE

- Sing/chant fun rhymes like *Five Little Monkeys Jumping on the Bed.*
- Encourage your child to make animal sounds by singing Old MacDonald Had a Farm
- Continue to sing, sing, sing!

#### Music activities to encourage SEEING AND HEARING

- Create your own kitchen band. Use pots, pans or plastic containers for drums. Fill cups, margarine tubs
  or empty canisters with beans, rice or sand for shakers. Be sure to seal the container well to prevent
  spills.
- Check your local library for illustrated songbooks, such as *This Old Man, Ants Go Marching, Old MacDonald,* and *What a Wonderful World.* Sing them with your child.

#### Music activities to encourage SOCIALIZATION and EMOTIONS

- Encourage your child's independence as appropriate. Use songs to encourage this, for example: (to the tune of All Around the Mulberry Bush)
   This is the way we pull on our shirt, Pull on our shirt, pull on our shirt
  - This is the way we pull on our shirt, So early in the morning.
  - (...wash our hands, put on our socks, etc.)
